## WHO WE ARE

Superior Kayak and Outdoor Adventure Club (SKOAC) is a non-profit, Twin Cities based club dedicated to fostering a supportive, educational environment for those interested in sea kayaking and other outdoor endeavors.



We desire to provide area paddlers with a community in which they can meet and befriend other paddlers with similar interests.

The club began in 1994 and now includes members from throughout the Midwest. We enjoy exploring Lake Superior and other destinations around the Upper Midwest by sea kayak, hiking trail or toting a sled on winter camping excursions. Some of our favorite paddling trips include the Apostle Islands, Isle Royale, the Slate Islands, Pukaskwa Park and Lake Powell.

Besides sea kayaking we hike the North Shore in the fall and take winter camping treks into the Boundary Waters Canoe Area. We also do local trips on the Mississippi and St. Croix Rivers and metro area lakes.

## TRIP REQUIREMENTS

We are a cooperative organization and depend on member-volunteers to organize trips and teach classes. Club trips are rated for different skill levels and participants must meet these guidelines. Members provide their own kayaking and camping gear in good repair. We follow safety guidelines recommended by the American Canoe Association.



## CLASSES & WORKSHOPS

Part of our mission is to provide opportunities for low cost, practical kayak training and experience.

We offer classes and workshops, pool sessions, mentoring opportunities and club-sponsored trips



to develop and apply your abilities. Each spring we offer the course “Basic Strokes and Rescues” followed by a weekend trip to the Apostle Islands. This introduces new paddlers to the practical techniques and skills needed to kayak Lake Superior safely. Periodically we offer workshops on navigation, menu planning, rescue and recovery techniques, bracing, Eskimo rolling and other topics of interest. Pool sessions are offered during the winter months to provide members an opportunity to practice techniques in warm water!
